Coast Swimming Club and Northern Arena are entirely independent organisations with a mutual working relationship.

Coast Swimming Club

- A non-profit making organisation run by a committee with one employee.
- Charges a monthly membership fee, invoiced quarterly.
- Members can enter swim meets and club events, join Swimming NZ and Auckland Swimming.

Northern Arena

- Privately owned award-winning pool and gym facility.
- Charges a monthly squad fee, invoiced monthly.
- Members belong to a squad and have coaching.
- Employs the coaches, organises squads and timetables, manages the facility.

What does Coast Swim Club do?

The Club Recorder

- Communication (club & meet information)
- Running Level 3 Meets
- Organises the Roster for meets
- Manages the Coast Swim Club accounts
- Liaise with committee, coaches, ASA & SNZ
- Record keeping
- Answering queries

The Committee

- Liaises with Northern Arena, the coaches, Recorder, ASA and SNZ
- General Club Management
- Organises away meets, camps, events.
- Oversees uniform.
- Fundraising

How is the club financed?

- Monthly membership fee
- Fundraising – Level 3 meets etc.
- Donations

What are the club's expenses

- Wages
- Level 3 expenses including ASA meet levy.
- General running expenses
- Coaches' expenses at meets
- Coast Swim Club uniform for coaches
- Club events
- Equipment – the starter, stop watches, the blocks, training aids (parachutes, medicine balls etc), printer, laptop.
- Subsidising away meets
- Financial assistance for our club swimmers on NZ teams.
